



The Nebraska Well Drillers Association has a long tradition in the ground water industry in Nebraska. It was established over seventy-five years ago and nurtured by key industry leaders along with academicians from the University of Nebraska. The organization has served the industry by providing technical training, new product exposure, idea sharing and fellowship among the members. The organization represents businesses and industries as well as technicians dealing with water well drilling, pump installation, manufacturing and supplying of equipment and material for water well work.

The organization has also become a significant voice in legislative and regulatory matters before the State of Nebraska. Current program areas include:

Education

The Association sponsors an annual convention and exposition where timely seminars are combined with displays of products and services critical to the water well industry.

It co-sponsors a technical workshop with the University each year to present topics on well construction; pump installation; maintenance and repair.

It also sponsors other seminars and field demonstrations on technical issues designed to provide the industry with other educational opportunities which will comply with continuing education requirements under Nebraska's licensing laws.

Members of the Association can take part in all these events at discount rates.

Industry News

A quarterly magazine, *Water Writes*, is published by the Association and distributed throughout the industry in Nebraska and surrounding states. It carries stories about industry issues and news, and features timely topics to assist the water well industry in professional improvement.

Insurance

A program of complete insurance protection is made available through the Association to contractors. Broad coverages and economic rates for participants have proven the program as one of the finest for the industry nationwide.

Government Liaison

Nebraska legislative activity is routinely monitored and issues of importance to the industry are discussed with lawmakers. The Association also works regularly with state agencies who deal with ground water issues, the University and the Water Well Standards and Contractors Licensing Board to represent members on industry issues.

Industry Promotion

The Association represents the industry on several committees dealing with ground water matters and participates in national and statewide forums. It provides articles and news stories from time to time to newspapers and trade publications to improve public understanding of the industry and of ground water.

Public Affairs

The Association is directly involved in youth and adult ground water education and contributes funds regularly to other such efforts to promote general knowledge about ground water in Nebraska. The Association provides a source of additional information to the public, including information on Association member contractors able to help a citizen solve a personal water problem.

Scholarships

The Association annually presents a financial aid scholarship to a Nebraska student working in water resources issues or planning a career in the industry. The Source of that award is the George E. Condra Scholarship Fund established and funded through the Association and its industry members.
